Duration:

The CUA40113 Certificate IV in Dance is delivered over 12 months full-time.

Subject Areas

Students will attend classes in classical ballet, jazz technique / progressions, hip hop, contemporary, lyrical, commercial dance, partnering, Pilates, strength & conditioning, acrobatics, audition techniques, vocal training, acting, industry knowledge, nutrition and wellbeing, and choreography.

The accredited component of the above course is delivered from October 2020 to September 2021. Students will continue their dance training until end of year showcase in early December 2021.

Credit Transfers can be applied to units completed, where a formal Transcript or Statement of Attainment is provided upon Enrolment. If a Transcript or Statement of Attainment is not available, the students will be expected to complete all units of competency listed in the course.

The CUA40113 Certificate IV in Dance qualification is awarded by Swinburne University of Technology (RTO# 3059) and delivered by Spectrum Dance Studios.

Enrolled students may be eligible for government assistance via Youth Allowance or Austudy.

Assessments

Spectrum Dance students are assessed on a formal and informal basis, and assessments will involve a mix of practical and theoretical work. The majority of assessments are practical.

Pathways

Graduates of the CUA40113 Certificate IV in Dance may be employed in a variety of dance performance contexts. Successful completion of the CUA40113 Certificate IV in Dance can lead to further training in the CUA50213 Diploma of Musical Theatre or CUA50113 Diploma of Dance (Elite Performance).
