Duration:

Students will attend classes in classical ballet, jazz technique / progressions, hip hop, contemporary, lyrical, commercial dance, partnering, Pilates, strength & conditioning, acrobatics, audition techniques, vocal training, acting, industry knowledge, nutrition and wellbeing, choreography, business management.

The accredited component of the above course is delivered from February to November 2021. Students will continue their dance training until end of year showcase in early December.

Credit Transfers can be applied to units completed, where a formal Transcript or Statement of Attainment is provided upon Enrolment. If a Transcript or Statement of Attainment is not available, the students will be expected to complete all units of competency listed in the course.

The CUA50213 Diploma of Musical Theatre qualification is awarded by Swinburne University of Technology (RTO# 3059) and delivered by Spectrum Dance Studios.

Enrolled students may be eligible for government assistance via Youth Allowance or Austudy.

Assessments

Spectrum Dance students are assessed on a formal and informal basis, and assessments will involve a mix of practical and theoretical work. The majority of assessments are practical.

Pathways

Graduates of the CUA50213 Diploma of Musical Theatre will have achieved expertise in dance, vocal and acting skills which meets the expectation of professional musical theatre, including cabaret, and small theatre shows. Graduates of this course are currently working in top venues in Australia and overseas on stage and television, and on cruise ship contracts all over the world.
